2 OVERVIEW

Key information on the implementation of the cooperation programme for the year concerned, including on financial instruments, with relation to the financial and indicator data.

The cooperation programme Interreg V-A Austria-Hungary was approved on 30 June 2015 after a long period of preparation that started with the first programming group meeting in April 2012.

The intensive period of programming hasn't ended with the approval. Throughout the year, in the period January-September 7 programming group meetings and 8 special eligibility working group meetings took place to round up the documents of the programme. The programme has been also represented in the core group to support the development of the eMS monitoring system.

The constituting meeting of the Monitoring Committee took place on 23 September, where the most important programme documents (rules of procedure for the MC, application form, selection criteria, and eligibility rules) and the TA projects were prepared for ratification. Their final approval took place in a written procedure.

After having closed the written procedure, the call was opened in eMS on 16 December 2015 for the four thematic priorities. At the same time the guide package was published, including a programme folder, the application handbook with its annexes (guide to fill in the AF, annexes to the application, AF template, checklist of annexes, selection criteria) and the eligibility handbook.

The call is continuous, meaning applications can be submitted at any time, but for a certain MC meeting only those are considered for decision that have been submitted 70 days before the meeting at noon, at the latest. As the first decision round will only take place in June 2016, applications thus have their "deadline" at 9 March 2016.

Commissioned by Interact, the electronic monitoring system eMS was successfully audited by an external company against the requirements of e-cohesion. The audit report was made available to the programmes using eMS. With the opening of the call in eMS and on the basis of the audit report, the Austria-Hungary programme fulfils the obligations for e-cohesion.





At the end of 2015 the new programme homepage was not available yet. All necessary information and documents like the opening of the call, programme documents and other communications were published on the homepage of the 2007-2013 ETC programme.

At the end of 2015, the communication strategy was in finalisation, the evaluation plan was not available yet and the designation procedure was still in preparation.

The EU-funded Interreg V-A programme supports cross-border cooperation projects in the border region Austria - Hungary. The main objective of the programme is to intensify cross-border contacts in the areas of economy, social affairs, culture and ecology, in order to strengthen the regional competitiveness and diminish regional disparities.

In the framework of the annual reporting to the European Commission (EC), the current report gives an overview to the broader public about the implementation of the programme in the year 2015.

The Interreg V-A programme -which has its roots in a long history of cross-border cooperation in Phare CBC, Interreg IIA, Interreg IIIA and ETC programmes- was approved on 30 June 2015.

The period of programming hasn't ended with the approval. The programme institutions, representatives of the participating regions and of the two member states have worked together intensely throughout the whole year to round up the documents of the programme.
