- 5. Boosting citizens' engagement in policy making and implementation
- 12 practical Recommendations aimed at:
 - Boosting exchanges between EU Officials and young people;
 - ❖ Boosting learning opportunities and clarify information on the EU & the funding available for young people;
 - Enabling young people to take action within Interreg Programmes and Projects.

Beyond the EU Year of Youth



• We encourage Interreg programmes to engage youth, not only as target groups for projects but actively in the programme!

Highlight possibilities for young people in the new programmes
 → e.g. scope for smaller actors (which youth organisations often are) to apply
 for funding (SPF, obligatory small scale projects, ISO1, simplification for small
 scale projects)







RECOMMENDATIONS BY YOUTH

9. Encouraging each Interreg programme to plan more calls more easily accessible by young people with simple rules and a dedicated budget.

10. Inviting young people in meetings and enable them to actively particicpate in the monitoring committees



Beyond the EU Year of Youth



- Good practice: To engage an IVY in the programme to work on how the youth aspect can be incorporated in the programme – during 2022 and beyond
- Good practice: To involve a youth representative in the Monitoring Committee or in the Steering Committee
- Good practice: To consult youth organisations in the public consultation of the programme
- Dedicated calls & campaigns targeting youth
- Mapping of all funding opportunities for young people in Interreg 2021-2027 programmes
