LEGAL BACKGROUND

- 1059/2021 Interreg Regulation (Art. 24) projects of limited financial volume are mandatory for the Interreg A programmes
- Interreg Programme Austria-Hungary introduces small-scale projects (open call system, decision on small-scale projects approximately two times a year by the Monitoring Committee)



PARTNERSHIP

- At least one Austrian and one Hungarian partner,
- overall maximum 3 partners,
- adding strategic partners to the partnership is not possible,
- possible beneficiaries: partners located in programme area and and/or such that have legally defined competences or field of function for certain parts of the area.



BUDGET

- Project size (total budget) must be between 25 000-200 000 €
- Extensive use of simplified cost options (SCOs)



TIME-PLAN

- Maximum project duration is 18 months



ACTIVITIES

- Only activities with a cross-border impact, i.e. no one-time actions or actions on only one side of the border. Such could be e.g. preparations for digital processes, training, seminars and courses, cooperation between microregions, municipalities, schools, sports clubs, organisation and realisation of summer schools, cross border events, etc.
- No investment in infrastructure and work (or costs in the respective category)




APPLICATION FORM

- Simplified application form (compared to standard projects)
- Activities organised in one work package



INTERVENTION LOGIC

- There's no separate overall objective, it is integrated into the single project specific objective
- The project work plan includes exactly one work package with a linked project specific objective, which is also linked to the programme specific objective
- The project work plan includes at least one output with a positive target value
- The project work plan shall include at least one result with a positive target value



 The selection of output indicator RCO87 (Organisations cooperating across borders) and result indicator RCR84 (Organisations cooperating across borders after project completion) is compulsory. Further indicators are optional.
