

8th MEETING OF THE MONITORING COMMITTEE

SUMMARY



Vienna
3-4 December 2025



The Monitoring Committee (MC) of the Interreg Austria-Hungary Programme held its eighth meeting on 3-4 December 2025, where it took the following decisions.

For the 2014-2020 programme:

- took note of the report on the state of implementation of the 2014-2020 programme.

On the 2021-2027 programme, the MC:

- took note of the report on the implementation of the 2021-2027 programme,
- approved the modifications of the Eligibility Manual (version 2.0),
- took note of the modifications of the Implementation Manual (version 3.0),
- received information on the major developments related to various other approved projects,
- received three complaints from lead partners regarding the de minimis classification of Hungarian project partners in the following projects
 - ATHU-0100133 GreenTech Plus,
 - ATHU-0100145 iHealth
 - ATHU-0100142 NextRegion
 - and, in the case of the ATHU-0100134 FEMinNova project, which was not subject to complaint, the following decision was made: in consultation with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, project promoters were asked to clarify their project activities during the preparation of the contract so that the MFA could confirm or modify its assessment of state aid.
 - In order to ensure the smooth handling of similar cases that may arise in the future, the MC grants the MA/JS the mandate to require a new assessment for the conclusion of the ERDF contract or contract amendment in the case of amendments that affect the MC's decision on state aid. Since, in practice, the MC merely confirms the Member State's assessment of state aid in its decision, it is authorised to ensure that any amendments are acceptable on the basis of the new assessment of state aid carried out by the Member State's representatives, but without a decision by the MC. The MC must be informed in all cases of any amendments to the project partner's assessment of state aid.
